INTRODUCTION

This Newsletter deals solely with the 2012 ISCA Conference in Greece and Turkey, and consequently this Newsletter serves as the Fourth Circular of the Conference.

FLIGHTS FROM ATHENS TO IOANNINA

We finally have the timetable of flights from Athens to Ioannina available for 3rd November 2012. There are two flights scheduled by Olympic Air www.olympicair.com.

These flights are:-

Flight No. 0A 800	Departs Athens 12:40	Arrives Ioannina 13:40
Flight No. 0A 808	Departs Athens 17:40	Arrives Ioannina 18:40

With only two flights being available it can be anticipated that these two flights may eventually look like ISCA charter flights, particularly the 17:40 flight. Those of you wishing to fly in to Athens on 3rd November 2012, and then fly onto Ioannina that day will, in all probability, find the 17:40 flight best suited to their schedules.

Renata and I plan to fly Athens to Ioannina on 2nd November 2012 to avoid the rush on 3rd November 2012. This will give us the best part of a day to rest up and start to enjoy our Greek experience. This is something that some of you, particularly those coming from far away, may want to do this as well.

The hotel in Ioannina will be available on 2nd November, for the same price, for early arrivals.

PRE-CONFERENCE AND POST-CONFERENCE

As this Conference will comprise initial travel day, three days of Conference in Greece, the transfer day, three days of Conference in Turkey, and concluding travel day, giving a total of nine days, there are no formal pre-conference and post-conference excursions planned. There will be, however, plenty of opportunities for those wishing to do so, to tarry a while in places such as Athens on the way to the conference and Istanbul at the end of the conference.
